

1984 is Happening Now – Part Eight

Residents described Saturday how police raided a house in the street earlier in the afternoon. Police added that the unarmed man, Jean Charles de Menezes, "challenged police and refused to obey orders."

So the police chased de Menezes down and shot him eight times.

That's what suspicious clothing and behavior will get you these days.

Consider what Orwell wrote in *1984*:

The patrols might stop you if you happened to run into them. 'May I see your papers, comrade? What are you doing here? What time did you leave work? Is this your usual way home?' Not that there was any rule against walking home by an unusual route: but it was enough to draw attention to you if the Thought Police heard about it . . . When once you had succumbed to thoughtcrime it was certain that by a given date you would be dead.

In *1984*, the populace was kept in fear by Emmanuel Goldstein—that dark, mysterious figure.

Today, the populace is kept in fear by Osama bin Laden—that dark, mysterious figure—and his Al-Qaida network, which our own Central Intelligence Agency (CIA) helped create.

Two days after the de Menezes shooting, Robin Cook, former Foreign Secretary under Tony Blair, wrote in the *London Guardian*:

"Bin Laden was . . . a product of a monumental miscalculation by western security agencies. Throughout the 80s he was armed by the CIA and funded by the Saudis to wage jihad against the Russian occupation of Afghanistan. Al-Qaida, literally, 'the database,' was originally the computer file of the thousands of mujahideen who were recruited and trained with help from the CIA to defeat the Russians. Inexplicably, and with disastrous consequences, it never appears to have occurred to Washington that once Russia was out of the way, Bin Laden's organisation would turn its attention to the west."

His friendships, his relaxations, his behaviour towards his wife and children, the expression of his face when he is alone, the words he mutters in sleep, even the characteristic movements of his body, are all jealously scrutinized. Not only any actual misdemeanour, but any eccentricity, however small, any change of habits, any nervous mannerism that could possibly be the symptom of an inner struggle, is certain to be detected. He has no freedom of choice in any direction whatever.
