

District of Cultism

The District of Columbia. That shining seat of our Constitutional republic. That home to our Federal government. That beacon of Christianity.

Or is it?

If all of the above is true, then what's with the occult symbolism built into the city's blueprint and the obelisk that juts into the sky from which the entire district can be viewed?

Let's look at the history of the District of Columbia:

Commissioned by George Washington, French Freemason Pierre Charles L'Efant laid out the district's design in 1791.

According to the article, "Masonic Symbols of Power in Their Seat of Power: Washington, D.C." (<http://www.cuttingedge.org/n1040.html>), it is stated:

"[L'Efant] planned to use the layout of Governmental Center to hide certain occultic magical symbols, which, when they were instituted, became one large Luciferic, or occultic, symbol. . . . As we study this occultic street design of Washington, D.C., Governmental Center, you will be seriously tempted to disregard this information. Please do not, because these symbols are "cunningly hidden" behind a form.

"The average citizen of any country simply cannot conceive that their leaders may consistently have evil in their hearts toward the very people they are leading. But, as we have consistently shown, this is precisely the case. Our leadership has been consistently moving us toward the Luciferic New World Order since 1776, always working through Secret Societies, and always misleading the people as to their true intentions."

However on a Masonic website (http://freemasonry.bcy.ca/anti-masonry/washington_dc/washington_dc.html) it states:

"There is no question that the intersections of Massachusetts Ave., Rhode Island Ave., Connecticut Ave., Vermont Ave. and K Street NW form a five pointed star. It is also true that many of the city's architects in the nineteenth and early twentieth century were freemasons. From these two facts, and a plethora of imaginative conjecture, many writers have concluded that the city was intentionally planned to promote an occult agenda.

"Does the street design of Washington, DC prove that there's a masonic or occult conspiracy?"

Check out the graphic and see for yourself.

Not only can you see the five-pointed star—which should be called by its very name *pentagram* and which, according to occult dogma, is a sign of evil when its two points are cast upward—but there can also be divined within the city's layout the intersecting lines formed by Pennsylvania and Maryland avenues and which meet at the Capitol building, forming the revered symbol of Masonry: the compass.

Then we have the Washington Monument, a huge obelisk whose symbolism dates back to the Egyptian Sun God Osiris and, by extension, his wife Isis and son Horus, all of whom represent a counterfeit occult trinity to mimic and mock that of Christianity's Father, Son and Holy Ghost.

The story of Osiris, according to occult Freemasonry legend, tells a tale of the Egyptian king Osiris' murder, committed by his brother Typhon, who slay him by inflicting a head wound. Isis, the wife of Osiris and the Egyptian Moon Goddess buried his body, but Typhon found it, chopped it into 14 pieces and scattered them in order to prevent Osiris' resurrection.

Isis searched for and gathered 13 of the parts, but the one she could not find was her husband's penis. So, instead, she created a substitute—a phallic symbol—shaped in the form of the obelisk.

The obelisk is occultic and, yes, though you see its shape everywhere, its origin is Satanic.

Consider this, too, the Washington Monument, brought to completion by Freemasons, is 555 feet tall. Multiply the feet by inches and you get 6660 inches.
