

Brink of a New Age – Part One

What is significant about the events that convulse our times?

Where are we, and where are we going?

The above epigraph is lifted from the introductory paragraph of a forward written for a *Look* magazine article entitled “The Brink of a New Age.”

The article comprised a compilation of statements crafted within the framework of the question: “What will future historians say was important about the years in which we live?”

The respondents were 20 noteworthy historians of the day to include Arnold J. Toynbee, Walter Lippman, Will and Ariel Durant, Bruce Catton, Arthur M. Schlesinger, Jr., and Reinhold Niebuhr, perhaps more a philosopher than historian.

Another item in that same edition of *Look* entitled “The Next 25 Years” served as a companion piece to the “New Age” article and included projections of what certain luminaries thought life would be like 25 years into the future, that is, 1987.

More so in this article than the former are we offered a glimpse into the coming *Novus Ordo Seclorum*—the motto which adorns one half of the two-sided Great Seal of the United States.

As discussed in a previous article, the term *Novus Ordo Seclorum* is tightly translated from Latin into English as *New Order of the Ages* and more liberally translated as *New World Order*.

The excerpts from “The Next 25 Years” that will appear here in the coming weeks are either the products of uncanny imaginations or, rather, a deliberate preview of the blueprint the Illuminati—the enlightened ones—have drawn up for civilization, which has now entered the 21st century or the epoch the Illuminati has welcomed as the *Age of Aquarius*.

Let’s begin with the most telling projection in the article, which was advanced by then-Israeli Prime Minister David Ben-Gurion, born David Gruen (Green) in Poland:

The Cold War will be a thing of the past. Internal pressure of the constantly growing intelligentsia in Russia for more freedom and the pressure of the masses for raising their living standards may lead to a gradual democratization of the Soviet Union. On the other hand, the increasing influence of the workers and farmers, and the rising political importance of men of science, may transform the United States into a welfare state with a planned economy.

The dismantling of the Berlin Wall signified the supposed end of that evil empire: the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics. Hmm. Why don’t we call it a downsizing dictated by economics.

Mother Russia dumped the mostly Muslim republics that shared very little with ethnic Russians. The other liberated nations like East Germany and the Ukraine became viable markets with which Russia could do business. Smart move.

But don’t think for a minute that Communism is dead.

The secret of what has or hasn’t taken place in Russia is embraced in a book written by former KGB officer and defector Anatoliy Golitsyn. In *New Lies for Old: The Communist Strategy of Deception and Disinformation*, Golitsyn claims Communism did not die but has gone temporarily into hiding to coerce Western nations to stand down, believing there is no longer a threat.

Further, Communism nor Marxism was created by Karl Marx or Frederick Engels. These men were merely the amanuenses through which the European Illuminati—led by the Rothschild banking houses—spread their doctrine.

Later, as documented by Antony C. Sutton in *Wall Street and the Bolshevik Revolution*, Western bankers and financiers financially backed Lenin and Trotsky in the overthrow of the Czar to be followed by a contingent of Western capitalists, to include Rockefeller and Ford families, who were ready to build the Russia infrastructure.

Despite what Ben-Gurion hypothesized would be the cause, the U.S. economy has moved from capitalism to a more socialistic and State-operated economy. And some would argue the nature of the U.S. economy since 1973 has been nothing less than planned.

So here we have the deliberate manipulation of both the Russian and U.S. economies from their previous polarities to a more common middle ground.

Ben-Gurion continues:

Western and Eastern Europe will become a federation of autonomous states having a Socialist and democratic regime. With the exception of the USSR as a federated Eurasian state, all other continents will become united in a world alliance, at whose disposal will be an international police force. All armies will be abolished, and there will be no more wars. In Jerusalem, the United Nations (a truly United Nations) will build a Shrine of the Prophets to serve the federated union of all continents; this will be the seat of the Supreme Court of Mankind, to settle all controversies among the federated continents.

Here Ben-Gurion predicts the European Union. And, right now, a movement advanced by the Council on Foreign Relations has been accelerated to create a union of Canada, the U.S. and Mexico. This is only a prelude to a complete integration of all 34 nations in the Western Hemisphere to achieve the final objective: the American Union.

Africa has already been federated into a union. Southeast Asia, too, is being configured for an imminent integration.

Afterward, all unions will be governed by a global government backed by a truly international Interpol and a massive army.

There will be no more wars because no nation will be able to disagree with or withdraw from the global government, that is, without incurring the wrath of the United Nations, whose armed forces will crush any rebellion.

This is not peace through harmony. This is peace through an abolition of dissent.

Ben-Gurion states that Jerusalem will be the seat of a world court and a place where a shrine to the prophets will be constructed.

Translation: There will no longer be national laws or judiciary. Instead, there will be an international rule of law. So we in the U.S. can forget our Constitution and jurisprudence.

The design for Jerusalem is for the city to become the capitol of the world, and couched in the world government's acceptance of all "prophets" is the formulation of a one-world religion where Judaism, Christianity and Islam are held on equal footing.

Was Ben-Gurion an impressive prognosticator or, as a proponent of the Masonic Zionist drive toward world domination, was he giving us a glimpse into the shape of things to come?
