

## THE *REAL* GOVERNMENT IN AMERICA

If you think back to the days after September 11, 2001, you might recall Vice-President Dick Cheney's comments about a *shadow government*.

The reference, most likely, was to a secret group consisting of certain cabinet members and perhaps some other governmental and military personnel, who, during emergencies, take control of the country, operating from a top-security installation at an undisclosed site in the mountains of Virginia or West Virginia.

In a different but no less substantial context, however, *shadow government* is also a reference to a body of policymakers that, since 1921, have run this nation, while allowing Americans to believe it's the President, his administration, and Congress that really make the decisions.

This body is known as the Council on Foreign Relations (CFR), and numbering among its members are Republicans, Democrats, former politicians, bankers, businessmen, military personnel, and media personalities.

This is the group that Rush Limbaugh denied existed. He did that—one can only surmise—because some people were becoming wise to the CFR and its role in American affairs both domestic and abroad. And Rush, being a paid shill for the government, had to go out there and spread some heavy disinformation to throw these truthseekers off the stench-scented trail of the shadowy government.

As you'll see, it's a strange mix that is found in the CFR.

For instance, you know how nasty those squabbles can get between Republicans and Democrats?

Well, guess who we find sitting side by side, taking care of business without the slightest hint of vitriol?

That's right. These very same political cats and dogs.

Behaving themselves and playing nice, these supposed partisan politicians seem to agree on all things linked to an agenda that promotes the severest of socialistic policy.

For a sampling:

CFR members among the GOP: Cheney, Condi Rice, William Frist, Chuck Hagel, Katherine Harris, Bob Graham and John McCain.

Among the Democrats: John Kerry, Chuck Schumer, Joseph Lieberman, and Jay Rockefeller.

Add to this mix some media types like Tom Brokaw, Dan Rather, Brian Williams, Paula Zahn, and Barbara Walters.

Then throw in some luminaries like former CIA chief Stansfield Turner, Newt Gingrich, Henry Kissinger, Alexander Haig, Sir Alan Greenspan (Why did the Queen knight him?), Jimmy Carter, David Rockefeller, Caroline Kennedy, and Zalmay Khalilzad.

But the biggest surprise of all is the CFR's odd couple, those two mortal enemies who kept us enthralled with their antics for over five years: Bill Clinton and Ken Starr.

Hmmmmmm.

So, what does this all add up to?

One of the most dangerous threats to the American way of life.

Strangely the CFR answers to no one, at least no one within the U.S. It dictates policy to the government and exercises control over every facet of American society, which is why the media—also subservient to the CFR—sheds virtually no light on the organization's doings. The CFR, while hiding in plain sight, is able to operate with impunity because it is beyond the reach of the ballot: We didn't elect these members, therefore we can't get rid of them.

Rene Worsmer, in his book, *Foundations: Their Power and Influence*, warned of the dangers presented by the CFR, stating that this organization, "another international complex, financed both by the Rockefeller and Carnegie foundations, overwhelmingly propagandizes the globalist concept.

Senator Barry Goldwater, demonized as a loose cannon because he spoke bluntly and honestly, told it straight about the CFR as well. In his memoir, *No Apologies*, Goldwater wrote: "The Council on Foreign Relations is the American branch of a society which was organized in England . . . [and] . . . believes national boundaries should be obliterated and one world rule established."

In *The New World Order*, Pat Robertson echoed Goldwater's statements about the CFR: "The goals of the Establishment are somewhat strange . . . At the central core is a belief in the superiority of their own skill to form a world system in which enlightened monopolistic capitalism can bring all of the diverse currencies, banking systems, credit, manufacturing, and raw materials into one government-supervised whole, policed of course by their own world army."

With regard to a "world army," the CFR is currently promoting a rather interesting concept. Max Booth, senior fellow for the CFR's National Security Studies, is advocating the use of illegal aliens and other non-nationals in the U.S. military.

Writing for the *Los Angeles Times*, Booth proposed that the our military swell its ranks not only with illegal immigrants but with "untold numbers of young men and women who are not here now but would like to come. No doubt many would be willing to serve for some set period in return for one of the world's most precious commodities—U.S. citizenship.

"The simplest thing to do would be to sign up foreigners for the regular U.S. military, but it would also make sense to create a unit whose enlisted ranks would be composed entirely of non-Americans, led by U.S. officers . . . It would be, in effect, a multinational force under U.S. command -- but one that wouldn't require the permission of France, Germany or the United Nations to deploy."

Do you think this is a good idea?

Whether or not you are in agreement, however, you might want to entertain a far more serious question: Should this kind of policymaking be left to a non-elected organization?

Though it may be hard to believe, the Council on Foreign Relations does more to dismantle the United States Constitution than it does to defend it. But the treachery does not end there. In a subsequent article, the CFR's origins will be examined, and that bit of information will more than likely shake your view of the history that has taken place since the signing of the Treaty of Paris in 1783.
