

Creating the perfect bogeyman – Part 3

There is no greater example of the perfect bogeyman than Tim Osman aka Tim Ossman aka Osama bin Laden.

Tim Osman was the name Osama went by in the eighties when he was procuring weaponry for the Mujahadeen, who were battling the Russians in Afghanistan.

According to an article written by J. Orlin Grabbe, “‘Tim Osman’ was the name assigned to him by the CIA for his tour of the U.S. and U.S. military bases, in search of political support and armaments. . . . There is some evidence that Tim Osman . . . visited the White House. There is certainty that Tim Osman toured some U.S. military bases, even receiving special demonstrations of the latest equipment. Why hasn't this been reported in the major media?”

Osama's trip to the U.S. was not his sole involvement with agents of our government. The French daily newspaper *Le Figaro* reported that in July, 2001, the CIA met with him in the American Hospital located in Dubai, United Arab Emirates.

Bin Laden was being treated there for a kidney ailment thought to have required dialysis from that point onward.

Other members of the bin Laden family also have had curious dealings with high profile personalities in the U.S.

Although it has vehemently been denied by the Bush Mob and many members of the Republican party and its lapdog media assets, Poppy Bush was indeed heavily involved with members of the bin Laden family through the global private equity firm known as The Carlyle Group, whose chairman, up to January, 2003, was Frank Carlucci, former Secretary of Defense under Ronald Reagan and former Deputy Director of the CIA under Jimmy Carter.

Another interesting element about the bin Ladens and the U.S. involves what happened in Tampa around Sept. 11, 2001.

It was reported that a LearJet 35 twice flew in and out of Tampa International Airport in violation of the national no-fly edict. Among the passengers being serviced by the aircraft numbered at least one bin Laden.

TIA at first denied that the flights had taken place, but *St. Petersburg Times* reporter Jean Heller wrote on June 9, 2004, that the “White House, aviation and law enforcement officials have insisted the flight never took place and have denied published reports and widespread Internet speculation about its purpose.

“But now, at the request of the National Commission on Terrorist Attacks, TIA officials have confirmed that the flight did take place and have supplied details.

“The odyssey of the small LearJet 35 is part of a larger controversy over the hasty exodus from the United States in the days immediately after 9/11 of members of the Saudi royal family and relatives of Osama bin Laden.”

This is yet another blatant example of the lies foisted upon the American people.

But Osama bin Laden is perhaps the biggest lie of all.

Australian researcher Norm Dixon wrote the following about the creation of Osama:

“Milt Bearden, the CIA’s station chief in Pakistan from 1986 to 1989, admitted to the January 24, 2000, *New Yorker* that while he never personally met bin Laden, ‘Did I know that he was out there? Yes, I did ... [Guys like] bin Laden were bringing \$20-\$25 million a month from other Saudis and Gulf Arabs to underwrite the war. And that is a lot of money. It’s an extra \$200-\$300 million a year. And this is what bin Laden did.’

“In 1986, bin Laden brought heavy construction equipment from Saudi Arabia to Afghanistan. Using his extensive knowledge of construction techniques (he has a degree in civil engineering), he built ‘training camps,’ some dug deep into the sides of mountains, and built roads to reach them.

“These camps, now dubbed “terrorist universities” by Washington, were built in collaboration with the ISI and the CIA. The Afghan contra fighters, including the tens of thousands of mercenaries recruited and paid for by bin Laden, were armed by the CIA. Pakistan, the US and Britain provided military trainers.

“Tom Carew, a former British SAS soldier who secretly fought for the *mujaheddin* told the United Kingdom’s *The Observer* in August 2003 that ‘The Americans were keen to teach the Afghans the techniques of urban terrorism—car bombing and so on—so that they could strike at the Russians in major towns. . . . Many of them are now using their knowledge and expertise to wage war on everything they hate.’

“Al Qaeda (the Base), bin Laden’s organization, was established in 1987-88 to run the camps and other business enterprises. It is a tightly-run capitalist holding company—albeit one that integrates the operations of a mercenary force and related logistical services with ‘legitimate’ business operations.

“Bin Laden has simply continued to do the job he was asked to do in Afghanistan during the 1980s—fund, feed and train mercenaries.”

Bin Laden is our creation, our guy, and he is being used right now as the bogeymen Americans have learned to hate—a gross emotion that revitalizes our tolerance and support for yet another foreign military debacle.

Bin Laden may very well have succumbed to kidney failure. Or he may be on the beach in Australia, or in a suite in the Hotel Peking. But if you think that he could go undetected traipsing around the mountains of Afghanistan, then you’re badly deluded.

In this day and age, satellite reconnaissance is so powerful and pervasive that bin Laden’s movements could not go unseen.

It was satellite photos that debunked the alleged 1990 Iraqi military build-up along the Kuwait border, which then-President Poppy Bush told the American people was underway.

Again, it was the *Times*’ Jean Heller who, having accessed satellite recon photos at the same time Bush was lying to the American people about the Iraqi build-up, proved there was no sign of a massive Iraqi troop and materiel deployment.

The satellite photos were so clean, however, that they showed the remnants of Rommel’s tank tracks across the North African desert.

Here we have another deception by a President to get us involved in another foreign war.

This is what Bush stated before a joint session of Congress: “We gather tonight witness to events in the Gulf as significant as they are tragic. 120,000 Iraqi troops with 850 tanks had poured into Kuwait and moved south to threaten Saudi Arabia.”

And, by the way, the date of Poppy Bush’s lies was Sept. 11, 1990.

It was also during this speech that Bush evoked the term *New World Order*, and he did it four times.

Tomb added, “Bin Laden has not been formally charged in connection to 9/11. . . .He has not been formally indicted and charged in connection with 9/11 because the FBI has no hard evidence connected Bin Laden to 9/11.”
